Alleluia, in place of 'God is the Lord'

Obikhod, Tone 8

Deacon (Priest): The Alleluia in the 8th Tone,
[Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.]

3 or 4 times,
depending on whether the verses are being read
concurrently with the choir, or in sequence

Choir:

Al - le - lu - ia, Al - le - lu - ia, Al - le - lu - ia.

✠ 1: *Blessed are they* whom Thou hast chosen and taken, O Lord.

✠ 2: *Their* memory is from generation to generation.

✠ 3: *Their* souls shall dwell with the blessed.

Troparia of the Departed

Priest, Deacon, or Reader:

O Thou only Creator who, with wisdom profound, mercifully orderest all things,
and givest unto all that which is useful:

Give rest, O Lord, to the soul(s) of Thy servant(s) who has (have) fallen asleep; ...

Choir:

he has his
for they have placed their trust in Thee, our Mak-er, and Fash-ion-er, and our God.
she has her

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;
now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

We have thee as a wall and a haven,
and an intercessor well-pleasing unto God, ...

Choir:

whom thou hast borne, O Vir-gin The-o-to-kos, the sal-va-tion of the faith-ful.
